

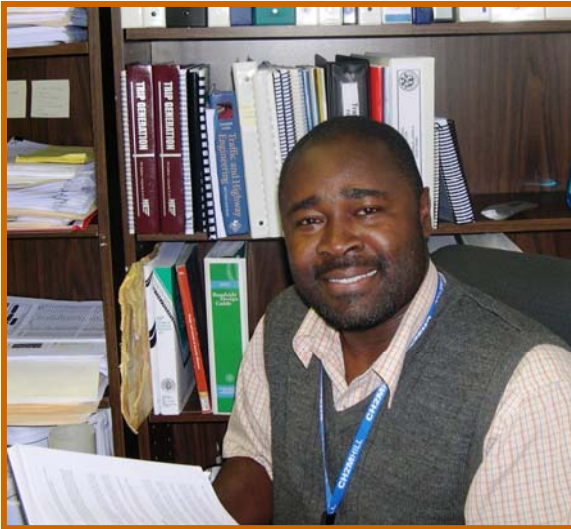

TIMING IS EVERYTHING! JUST ASK OUR TRAFFIC ENGINEER KWABENA OFOSU, P.E.

Mr. Ofosu recently concluded a traffic control signalization study along segments of Babcock and Malabar Road to determine cost-effective approaches to reduce high commuter traffic congestion. The study evaluated the impact of

individual intersections as well as the signal coordination between all intersections along the segments to determine if signal timing affected traffic congestion.

In addition to analyzing signal timing, a review of traffic crash data for the study corridor also revealed that 60% of crashes were rear end collisions while side swipes accounted for 14%. Among the suggestions to improve congestion was the implementation of a retiming and coordination plan to better coordinate traffic signals.
